NEW ECCLESBOURNE HEAD TO BE APPOINTED SOON

The Governors of the prestigious, award winning Ecclesbourne School are holding meetings in the New Year to discuss the recruitment of a new Head Teacher to succeed the retiring Lesley Underhill.

It's understood there is a mixture of in-house and outside applicants for the post in succession to Mrs Underhill who is expected to step down in February.

A TRADITION ENDS AS DOCTOR BARBARA RETIRES

After a career of 35 years Dr Barbara Leyland, GP in Duffield since 1975 has retired as a full time partner at Appletree Medical Practice.

Barbara, whose family were GPs in the village for 104 years, grew up in the Mason family home at The Gables, Town Street surrounded by the paraphernalia of a doctor's practice.

From an early age she determined to follow in the footsteps of both her father Dr. James Mason and grand father Dr. Herbert Mason before him.

After qualifying as a GP in 1973 Barbara worked in London before returning to Duffield to join the family practice.


Barbara has seen the world change since her earliest recollections of life as a GP, not least in mode of transport. Her grandfather would ride

out on horse back to see patients in outlying areas whilst her father was regularly to be seen reversing his Morris Minor Traveller out on to the busy A6. In 1995 the two doctors' surgeries in the village merged to form Appletree which has gone from strength to strength.

Barbara is following hot on the heels of another long established doctor, Chris Brentnall who himself retired earlier this year.

Some 250 patients gathered at the Surgery to wish them farewell and see them commemorate the opening of the new wing of the surgery with the planting of an apple tree (see picture).



My seven year old American grandson Ezra asked me if it was true that time speeds up when you get older and that time for kids is slower!

"Most definitely seems that way!" I replied. "The good thing for me is that when I am with vou, time seems to slow down for me -and it seems to speed up again when you are not around." He was satisfied with the answer and reflected that for him, his birthday never comes quick enough and the holidays always seem a long way off. This looking into the future and living life ahead of ourselves is a feature of being human. Not so the in the natural landscape.

Time as we know it is a manmade, artificial construct and, before we found mechanical ways of dividing the day and the year, we too, like the animals and plants, were more instinctive and understood time in terms of daylight and darkness, warmth and cold, wet and dry. It is on cold, grey wet days like

It is on cold, grey wet days like the one I am experiencing today whilst I write that I feel very like a wild creature – understand that urge to bury myself away somewhere warm and dry, curl up and go to sleep and wake up when it is warm and sunny again. Unlike humans who can fly away to sunnier climes or light a roaring fire, the animals on the Meadow have had to prepare for winter to ensure their survival in a number of ways.

Although it is possible to see toad tadpoles in winter, the frogs and toads are mostly safely at the bottom of the ponds buried in the leaf litter, breathing through their skin and slowing their

metabolism. The insects
in various stages of
their lives are also
battening down
for winter -some
as chrysalids,
some as eggs,
some as
adults.
The bird life
has changed the swans,

the swans, ducks and coots have successfully reared their

offspring and these

fledglings are now

mostly independent of their parents. The adults have moved back to the rivers and the waters are not being regularly dipped by the swallows and house martins any more -they have long ago flown back to Africa -but the copses are alive with the twittering of mobs of long tailed tits and goldfinches looking for seeds. The kingfisher still patrols up and down the river -a high pitched whistle and a flash of turquoise usually all we see or, if we are lucky to find his fishing root of a branch

usually all we see or, if we are lucky to find his fishing post of a branch overhanging the water, treated to a dive and a successful catch.

The young buzzards are not wheeling and mewing their calls high in the sky as they have all

summer and the holes and runs of field mice and voles are now exposed in the shorter grass. The wasps nest underground in the middle of the path is not still being visited every few seconds.

All the workers are now dead or dying and the queen is tucked away somewhere

out of harms
way, ready to
start a new
colony in the
Spring.
The spider
webs are less
visible and the
grass has its last

flush of green before the frosts stunts its growth.

The valley is shrouded in mist in the morning and the cold, dank

morning and the cold, dank air takes time to clear with the weak winter sunshine.

Trees are rimed with frost and the leafless branches look lifeless. The seed heads on the reeds around the ponds glisten with gem like drops and will be a source of food and refuge for insects and birds alike through the bitter months.

Yet, whilst clearing the alder saplings and some of the willow shrubs from around the wetland to preserve the views, it was lovely to see the colourful purple/red and silvery white buds on the branches – new life ready but well protected and waiting for the warmth and light.

Hazel trees have catkins already formed hanging from their twigs but tightly closed against the cold -these will be some of the first things to burst into life in the Spring.

All the trees have now temporarily shut down for winter and the sap has retreated, preventing growth during this adverse time.

Sloes on the blackthorn bushes will be the food of last resort for some creatures -they are sweeter after a frost but their astringent, mouth puckering taste so favoured for flavouring gin is an acquired one for many.

The buried hazel nuts and acoms will be sought by the hungry squirrels when winter begins to bite and those buried by the jays may well sprout into young trees in the Spring. The copses are full of spindly, saplings of oak, ash, and silver birch from where seeds and nuts have fallen or been buried in this way.

No sign of balsam plants now - the annual ones have done their job (if they weren't pulled up) and spread their seed and died back completely. The occasional dandelion and yarrow flower still gives pleasure but mostly the Reserve is at rest, shut down for the weeks to come.

It won't be for long.
Remember not to look at the clock too much, nor forget to live fully each day and suddenly we will be past the shortest day and on the turn of the year.

ADVICE ON SNOW CLEARING FROM DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Following concerns raised by members of the public about clearing paths of snow and their potential liability
Derbyshire County Council have issued the following guidance with a view of assuring residents:

Provided that members of the public who clear snow and ice from pavements or minor roads near their property take reasonable care and apply a common sense approach in doing so, they are unlikely to find themselves being held liable if someone has an accident and is injured on the area they have cleared.

If members of the public take action to clear snow and ice they should ensure that they do not create any further hazards by doing so.

For example:

Do not clear ice using boiling water which then freezes over

the surface of the road

Do not clear an area leaving an obstructive mound of snow on the pavement

Do not attempt to clear the snow if you feel that this will cause you physical difficulty

Take reasonable care in all of the circumstances

A reminder of some advice to help with protection of property over the Christmas and holiday

Most of this advice is easy to implement inexpensively, but it's often simple things that make a difference and can often be overlooked in the frenetic run up to Christmas.

Never leave bags of presents on display in your car

Always lock everything in the boot and try not to leave a car containing valuables unattended for long

Mark expensive presents, such as electronic equipment, with your postcode by engraving or using an ultra violet pen, and possibly take photos of them Store Christmas presents in

places which are well hidden and difficult to reach - for example at the back of a wardrobe, or in the loft Try to avoid putting presents under the tree too long before Christmas - the longer they are on display the more opportunity there is for burglaries to take place Try not to position the Christmas tree right by the window, as this will attract attention to presents from

anyone looking in

Even if you are at home, remember to keep back doors and windows locked. Careless home security can make things easier for thieves

Check whether your insurance covers additional Christmas presents.

Be extra vigilant when admitting strangers into your home.

Keep the door chain secured, always ask for identification and only invite callers into your home if you are completely satisfied that they are who they say they are.

Fourteen year old Ecclesbourne schoolboy Cameron Mclean is determined to qualify for the paralympics in 2016.

For the last two years Cameron has been going into Ecclesbourne school at 8:20am each school day to carry out a weight training programme specifically designed for upper body strength.

He has now entered his fourth week of technical training in a racing wheelchair which is on loan from the Cerebral Palsy Sports association.

His progress has been so

encouraging that he has extended his exercise regime to include the use of an exercise bike and a rowing machine, and all of this is on top of a weekly swimming endurance session Ashbourne Leisure Centre! Cameron would dearly like to racing his own wheelchair as the borrowed chair will ultimately have to be returned.

Alan Bradshaw,co-ordinator of Cameron's training programme, said: "The dedication Cameron has shown is inspirational. Although he

can walk with the aid of sticks much of his time is spent in a wheelchair.

"To see him propel himself at speed in the racing wheelchair is a delight and it has done wonders for his self esteem and confidence

"How wonderful it is to provide this young man with a sense of purpose. I sincerely hope his dream comes true, he thoroughly deserves it."

Unfortunately such purpose built machines cost in the region of two thousand pounds.
