## DUFFIELD ON VERGE OF MASSIVE RESURGENCE

A real boost to the economy of the village will take place soon as Duffield Hall is about to come to life again after lying empty and unused for months and many empty Town Street shops will soon be trading again.

The Hall and surrounding outbuildings are under offer and it is fully expected that agents Colliers International will be announcing the completion of a deal between the buyers and the owners Nationwide Building Society by the end of next month.

The exact details of many of

the deals are not being released yet but are under genuine offers.

There was great interest in the Hall and grounds including enquiries from developers, hoteliers, investors and companies seeking to move their offices into a prestigious site.

The fact that the Hall is listed reduced interest among some would be developers and conversion to a hotel was a non-starter due to the flooding dangers.

Some acreage, including two residential bungalows have already been sold and it seems



clear now for the Hall to be in full use, providing the village stores with many potential customers after some lean months.

IMS , an award winning company. are opening in Town Street on March 25th; Beauty Therapy is moving into the refurbished old Chinese takeaway at the junction of Town Street and Tamworth Street on April 6th and there is likely to be another delicatessen on Town Street among new owners moving in to main road premises which have been shut down for too long.







The team at Croots raised £600 during a sponsored cycle ride on




exercise bikes to mark the shop's fourth birthday last summer, and collected a further £70 by staging a raffle.



#### I AM A MOLE AND I LIVE IN A HOLE UNTIL I COME UP FOR AIR

They didn't move. Two or three lines of pigeons were perched at the far end of the field, all facing the same way, devouring the rape seed plants that were struggling to make growth despite being water logged as they have been all the time they have been in the ground.

Ignoring the two scarecrows that were drunkenly leaning, half blown over in the recent winds, the birds seemed to be having a field day and the prospect for the crop did not look promising. Until, that is, when looking to the right by the hedgerow, a small green tent with a rough piece of sacking across the front could be spied.

On second inspection, the pigeons in the field were too still and indeed, were decoys designed to lure down their living cousins who have been devouring these plants regularly and against whom the farmer was practicing this deception, poised as he was inside the tent with his gun, ready to shoot as many as he could once they landed.

It has not been a good year for anyone trying to grow crops. The wet weather that has plagued us since last May has continued into this New Year and the main beneficiary on the Meadow seems to have been the moles (if the number of molehills is anything to go by)! The sudden appearance of these mounds of earth signifies a very healthy mole population and also an abundance of their favourite food - earthworms - most of which live quite near the soil's surface.

When you see a blackbird or a thrush quartering the lawn, the worms they are seeking are not far below them or are even showing through the surface of the ground and they can feel the vibrations and see minute movements.

We have approximately 25

species of earthworm in this country and they range in size from 12 cm although our biggest -the lobworm -can stretch to 35cm when moving. All earthworms Millennium Meadow breathe through their skin and have remain moist in order

Di Hancock do this. to However, they also have to come to the surface when it rains or when the ground becomes flooded to prevent them from drowning.

The water table on the Meadow has remained high all year and the worms, of which there can be as many as 20-40 in each square metre of soil, have remained very near the surface all the time and the moles have certainly benefitted.

It has been estimated that on farmland, the weight of the worms underneath the soil can be greater than that of the livestock on the surface!

soil Poor mav have 250,000/acre whereas rich

farmland can have up to 1,750,000/acre. Lobworms (common name "night

crawlers") live vertical in burrows that usually deep into the soil and they can brace themselves against the

side of the burrow broadening their tail. They come to the surface during the night and devour

fallen leaves and rotting vegetation before returning to their burrows where the excreted faeces (worm casts) fertilizes the soil. Worm burrows generally aerate the provide and good drainage holes for the rainwater permeate to through.

A11 our worms are hermaphrodite, which means that they have both male and female reproductive organs. However, they need another worm to mate with and once that has happened each worm separates and the clitellum belt like glandular

swelling found about one third of the way down the body of a sexually mature worm and which contains the egg capsule - slides forward collecting sperm as it goes before sliding off the head and sealing itself into a lemon shaped cocoon. The fertilized eggs develop inside this cocoon before fully formed immature worms emerge after 3-6 weeks.

A recent study by a PhD student in Belgium reporting in the journal "Ethology" found that worms do not seem to communicate chemically in any way but do respond to each other's touch. Thus they will follow one another and seem to have a herd instinct, forming defensive balls when required.

Talking of herds -the cattle will have been on the Meadow in the last few weeks of February and the beginning of March and I am thanking responsible dog owners for keeping their dogs on leads during this period. The cattle will have a chance to graze down some of the grass to reduce its vigour ahead of the flower show we expect across the Meadow in May/June. We are late with this activity because one animal needed an operation and the farmer needed a new County Parish Holding Number for the Meadow.

This is an EU Government requirement for all land that is to be used for agriculture (including grazing) to be registered and if animals are to be moved, allows them to be tracked to stop the spread of diseases. Given the parlous state of the ability to track the sequences in our food chain recently, we should be glad that this regulation is being observed!

By the way, I don't know if the farmer was successful in ridding his field of pigeons but the water logged ground may decide his crop's fate anyway.

# SCAM TRICKSTERS ARE AT IT AGAIN

There do seem to be several scams circulating at present as I've heard from more Duffield residents.

One concerned an email purporting to be from HM Revenue and Customs stating that the lady was due for a refund of income tax and to 'click on a button' to receive this.

The give-away was that it was addressed to Dear Sir/Madam, they should know who they are addressing!

This particular scam has also been received by other Duffield residents.

Another scam was a telephone call supposedly from the police stating that they were concerned that someone was illegally using a stolen credit card in the lady's name and asking for the credit card

number.

If you ask how to be sure that it is the police, in order to reassure you they ask you to put the phone down and dial 999 when a different person answers who then passes you onto the original caller.

This is achieved by the caller not disconnecting the call and so leading you to believe that the call is genuine.

This particular scam was circulating a while ago but from another 'official' organisation.

Please do be wary.

#### Car Security:

The police wish to remind motorists to make sure they leave their cars secure as it only takes a couple of seconds for someone to jump in and make off with their vehicle.

Always make sure it is locked, even when just nipping into a shop or waiting for it to defrost.

The best advice is simply not to leave it unlocked or unattended with the engine running.

Stay with the car at all times and be aware of any suspicious activity.

#### Motorists are advised to:

- Not leave the keys in the ignition or the engine running whilst unattended
- Always lock the car before leaving it unattended
- Do not leave the keys in an obvious place such as the glove box
- Remove all valuables from the vehicle wherever possible
- Whenever possible leave your car in a secure garage or in a well-lit location
- Consider additional security including alarm, window etching, steering lock, smart water or tracker device.


